

Introduction to Judging

BC Diving is pleased to announce that we will be offering an "Introduction to Judging" Clinic. This five day clinic will be spread out over Saturday morning throughout the months of November, December and January, and is designed for individuals who wish to learn more about the requirements of becoming a Judge, as well as a review for our Regional/Provincial Level Officials. If you've always wondered what it was like to sit in a Judges chair and what to look for when judging a dive, now is your chance to test the water.

Introduction to Judging

<u>Day 1 – Introduction</u> (November 24, 2012. 8 – 10 am.)

A basic overview of the Judging Program with focus on the Events, Dive Numbers and Position, Degree of Difficulty, and Scoring the Dive. There will be deck time covering Deck set-up and Official Placement as well as "Practice Judging".

<u>Day 2 - Elements of the Dive Part 1 (December 1, 2012.</u> 8 – 10 am.) Focus is on the *Start Position and the Approach*, and the *Take-off* with deck time judging only these elements of the dive.

<u>Day 3 - Elements of the Dive Part 2 (Dec 15, 2012. 8 – 10 am.)</u> Flight and Entry with deck time focusing on the judging of only these elements of the dive.

Day 4 - Judging the Dive (January 12 8 – 10 am.) A review of the previous days and Synchronized Judging, with more time allotted to deck time Judging.

<u>Day 5 - Rules and Regulations</u> (January 19 8 am – 12 noon.) This section will cover the General Rules including; Competitions/Format, Statement of Dives, Duties of Referee and Assistant Referee, Summary of Penalties. A practice protest Event Appeal Procedure - Event Jury of Appeals will be held.
