Americas Masters Games 2016 concludes successful partnership meetings with officials of the World Masters Games 2017

The leadership team of the *Americas Masters Games 2016 (AMG)* met this past week with counterparts from the 2017 World Masters Games (Auckland NZ) and agreed to work together to create high quality sporting and cultural experiences for all participants.

"The chance to meet with AMG leadership, key stakeholders, provincial sport organizers and many potential participants was of great value to us and we look forward to continuing this close collaboration in the years to come. Both of these Games will offer 28 different sports and are open to all mastersaged athletes over the age of 30, where no prior qualification or specific skill level is required. The AMG 2016 is planning for up to 10,000 participants over the course of August 27 to September 4 2016, in facilities across the city of Vancouver.
